

General Information

Schools and districts will have three options for accessing, viewing, and sharing results from the spring 2021 administration of the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP): OnDemand Reporting (ODR), Final Published Reporting, and Parent Portal.

OnDemand Reporting (ODR)

Achievement level reporting for the individual student will be available in PearsonAccess^{next} in the **Reports** option (*Reports > OnDemand Reports*) beginning in April 2021.

- Results will be available for tests administered with in-person proctored and remote testing. Note: Reports for students taking remote testing will **ONLY** be available via ODR.
- There will be separate **Student Detail Reports** for each test (Mathematics, Reading, Language and Writing, and Science). An English Language Arts (ELA) Student Detail Report will also be produced if the Reading and Language and Writing tests are taken in the same mode – in-person proctored or remote testing.
- Results will also be available, by test, in **Student List Reports** (downloadable as .pdf, .csv, or .xls file formats).
- Results will be available after scoring of each test has been completed – approximately 10 days after testing for online tests; and approximately 15 days after paper-and-pencil tests are returned to Pearson.

Final Published Reporting

Achievement level reporting for the individual student, school, district, and state will be available in PearsonAccess^{next} in the **Reports** option (*Reports > Published Reports*) beginning in early August 2021. NOTE: ONLY STUDENTS WHO WERE ADMINISTERED THE IN-PERSON PROCTORED ISASP WILL BE IN THE FINAL PUBLISHED REPORTS.

- **Individual Student Report (ISR)**, one per student, presenting all tests taken.
 - NEW FOR SPRING 2021: Each ISR will contain metadata which may be used by your student information system (SIS) provider to upload students' reports to their individual student profiles.
- **Class Roster**, by grade and subject (ELA, Mathematics, and Science).
- **Achievement Level Summary** (school- and district-level reports).
 - Presents "All" students and disaggregates among various demographics.
 - Offers comparisons to district- and state-level results.
- **Student Data File (SDF)**, in .csv file format.
 - The SDF will contain data for ALL STUDENTS TESTED (IN-PERSON PROCTORED AND REMOTE).
 - The SDF is designed to be imported into many common SIS solutions used by districts (e.g., JMC, PowerSchool, Infinite Campus).

Parent Portal

The Parent Portal is a secure online site, hosted by Pearson, offering Iowa families direct access to view their student's results outside of the school setting.

- The SDF will contain a unique **Claim Code** that districts may choose to share with families.
- By entering the student's first name, last name, date of birth, and claim code, families can access their student's ISR in the Parent Portal.

- NOTE: CLAIM CODES WILL ONLY BE PROVIDED FOR STUDENTS WHO WERE ADMINISTERED THE IN-PERSON PROCTORED ISASP.
