

## Background

The **Learning Management System (LMS)**, supporting the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP), is open for the spring 2025 administration. LMS hosts all the training modules for the ISASP and maintains records of successfully completed modules. The following trainings are available:

- Technology Readiness 2024-25
- Test Coordinator Overview 2024-25
- Test Administration Training 2024-25
- Test Security 2024-25

## Accessing LMS

Access and resources for the LMS are available on the [Training page](#) of the ISASP Portal.

LMS accounts will need to be created by users to sign into the system and view trainings. The process to create an LMS account will differ depending on if the individual user has an account in PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup> or not. There are short video guides posted on the [Training page](#) of the ISASP Portal to help users with creating their LMS accounts.

**\*Important:** Disabled or deleted PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup> accounts will result in the LMS accounts getting archived. Ensure PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup> accounts are in active status first. Changes made to PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup> accounts will be reflected the next day in LMS.

## LMS Account Roles

LMS accounts have two roles, **Learner** and **Manager**. All accounts will have the Learner role to view and **document self-completion of trainings**. Some accounts will have the Manager role; this role is granted to active Coordinators in PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup>. The Manager role can track training statuses of staff at the school or district, and **document group training sessions**.

## Viewing Training Modules

Supported web browsers for LMS are Google Chrome for Windows 10 and 11, and Safari for macOS X 10.12–15. Ensure the following are enabled in the browser settings: JavaScript, third-party cookies, and local storage.

## Training Requirements

The *Test Security 2024-25* training is **required** for all educators (coordinators, proctors, teachers, paraeducators) involved with the administration of ISASP. While paraeducators are not allowed to proctor the test, they could be exposed to the test or test materials and are thus required to complete the Test Security training. This requirement applies to educators in public districts and nonpublic schools.

In addition to the Test Security training, at least one (1) Coordinator at the public district or nonpublic school must complete the *Test Coordinator Overview 2024-25* and *Test Administration Training 2024-25* trainings in advance of online testing or receiving paper materials.
