

**State Proficiency Results**

State results for the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) are provided in this bulletin. ISASP is a standards-based assessment designed to provide information to schools and families on how students are performing on the Iowa Core Academic Standards. Performance level descriptors specify the level of performance on a test that is required for a student to be classified into a given performance level. ISASP performance is reported as defined by the state of Iowa.

	Performance Level Descriptors
<b>Advanced</b>	Students performing at the <b>Advanced</b> level demonstrate thorough competency over the knowledge, skills, and abilities that meet the requirements for their grade level associated with academic readiness for college and career in the subject area.
<b>Proficient</b>	Students performing at the <b>Proficient</b> level demonstrate adequate competency over the knowledge, skills, and abilities that meet the requirements for their grade level associated with academic readiness for college and career in the subject area.
<b>Not-yet-Proficient</b>	Students performing at the <b>Not-yet-Proficient</b> level have not yet demonstrated the knowledge and skills to be classified as Proficient.

The results include all students that completed a secure administration of the ISASP during the spring of 2024. Results for the 2023 administration are also provided. The tables provide the percent of students that were classified into each of three proficiency levels based on their test performance.

ISASP Test	Grades	State Trends
<b>English Language Arts (Reading and Language/Writing)</b>	3-11	The percent of students that were proficient or advanced in ELA increased between 2023 and 2024 for students in grades 6, 7, 8, 9, and 11.
<b>Mathematics</b>	3-11	The percent of students that were proficient or advanced in Mathematics remained consistent between 2023 and 2024 with some slight variation from grade-to-grade.
<b>Science</b>	5, 8, 10	Proficiency rates decreased in Science between 2023 and 2024 in all three grades.
