

## Background

OnDemand Reports (ODR) for the spring 2025 Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) are now available.

A new reporting feature, the **Interim Achievement Level Summary**, is also now available. This report provides a **snapshot** of current achievement levels at the school and district.

## OnDemand Reports

ODR are available by individual student, as well as for groups of students, and may be viewed online or downloaded from PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup>.

ODR allow schools and districts to view preliminary student achievement results prior to the release of final Published Reports. These reports are labeled preliminary because they do not contain the district averages or an individual student's results from prior years. These results may be shared with students and their families.

## Interim Achievement Level Summary

The purpose of the Interim Achievement Level Summary is to provide schools and districts a snapshot of current achievement levels. **The aggregated data in this report are subject to change as additional student test scores are processed and incorporated into the system.**

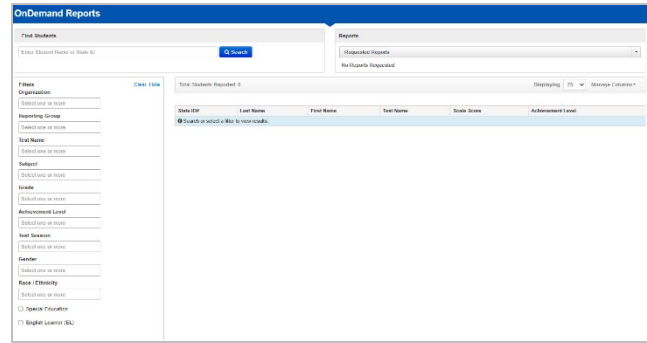
To access the Interim Achievement Level Summary:

1. Sign into PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup>. Verify you are in the 2024-25 administration year at the top.
2. Go to *Reports > Interim Achievement Level Summary*.
3. For this report, *Grade* is going to be a required field, located on the left in the *Filters* box. Only one grade may be selected at a time.
  - a. Additional filters can be applied to disaggregate results. The filter options need to be applied consistently. For example, applying both the filters for a grade 3 Reading test session and for the high school building will not display a graph.
4. Hovering your mouse pointer over an achievement level will display the student counts.
  - a. Note, student counts may vary as processing progresses and should be checked for each test on a graph before interpreting the results.
5. Click the *Print* button on the right to produce a formatted PDF report. Page 2 of this PDF report will provide student counts to aid with interpretation. When the report is prepared, it will be available under the *Requested Reports* drop-down.
  - a. Prepared reports for both ODR and Interim Summaries will show up in this drop-down; you can remove prepared reports by clicking on the "x."

**Please note:** If student counts are less than 10, graphs will be suppressed for student data anonymity.

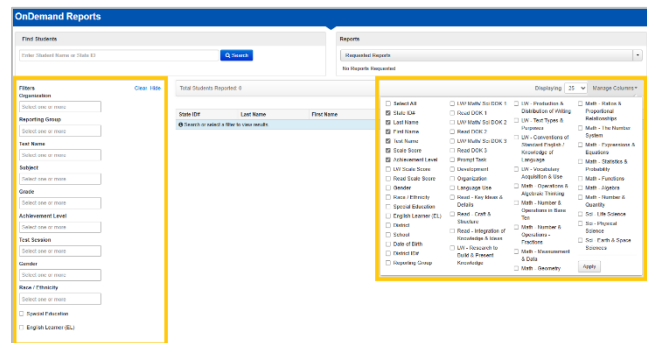
1. OnDemand Reports (ODR) are posted in PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup> after scoring verification is completed. Results are uploaded to ODR within two weeks for tests taken online, and within three weeks after paper tests are received by Pearson.

To view ODR, sign into PANext, then go to *Reports > OnDemand Reports*.



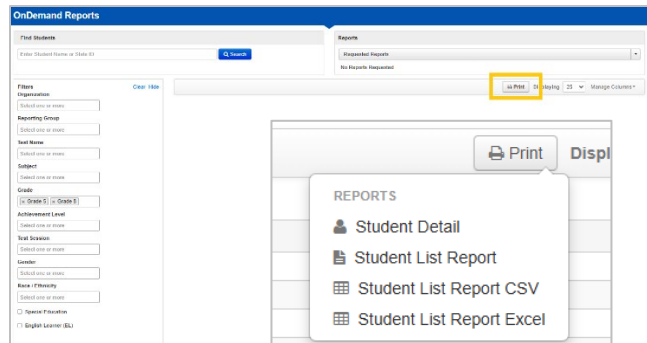
2. On this page, posted reports will be available. Applying filters from the left will narrow the displayed results. Additional detail columns can be added or removed in *Manage Columns* on the right. Clicking the blue "i" by the student's state ID will pull up that student's Detail Report in a separate window.

Checking the *Select All* box in *Manage Columns* will select all detail columns (due to the amount of data, it is best to print this as the Student List Report in CSV or Excel file formats).



3. When your desired results are displayed, click on the *Print* button for the following print request options:

- a. Student Detail Report (PDF), limited to 2,500 student tests at a time
- b. Student List Report (PDF), limited to 10,000 student tests at a time
- c. Student List Report (CSV and Excel), limited to 100,000 student tests at a time



4. Your print request will show up in progress under the *Requested Reports* drop-down. When using the *Print* function, please be aware that selecting the maximum limit of tests (e.g., 2,500 tests for the Detail Report) may result in processing times of 3–7 minutes.

You will be able work on other PANext tasks or sign out without interrupting the system working to produce your file.
